Straight from the Heart Sampler by Christen Brown




Materials

- '7" square each of cotton fabric and lightweight iron-on interfacing
- Cotton floss: 3 skeins in different colors, or 1 skein of variegated colors
- Needles: embroidery or cotton darner
- Scissors: fabric, paper, embroidery
- Chalk pencil
- Ruler

Directions

- **1.** Iron the interfacing to the wrong side of the cotton fabric.
- **2.** Cut out the heart shape pattern pieces (see back page).
- **3.** Draw a 6" square onto the fabric with a chalk pencil.
- **4.** Thread the needle with 6 strands of floss, or less. Add more floss or use a different color for each step.

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- **5.** Using the straight stitch, embroider on the outer line.
- **6.** Draw a second set of lines with a chalk pencil, inside the square 1/4" away from the first set.
- **7.** Using the straight stitch, embroider on the second set of chalk lines.

- 8. Pin the heart shapes in place using the *Diagram* as a guide. Draw around the edge with a chalk pencil. Remove the pins and the patterns.
- **9.** Using the straight stitch, embroider around the outer edge of each heart shape.
- **10.** Draw a line 1/8" around each embroidered heart shape with a chalk pencil.
- **11.** Using the straight stitch, embroider on the chalk lines.
- **12.** Draw a line down the center of each heart with a chalk pencil.
- **13.** Using the straight stitch, embroider on the chalk lines.
- **14.** Draw the inner lines of the square with a chalk pencil.
- **15.** Using the straight stitch, embroider on the chalk lines with floss.

Finish as you would like!
